WEEK 1

- 🐾 Review how puppies learn – refer Manual
- 🐾 Managing biting and toilet training – refer Manual
- 🐾 Working through Socialisation list in Manual ensuring all new experiences are happy ones – give distance and jolly puppy up with anything they are worried about
- 🐾 Train your puppy to go to a place – bed or mat
- 🐾 Start using short leash tie up next to puppies mat 30-50cm lead and remain with puppy getting them to settle
- 🐾 Practice training your marker word 'yes' or 'good'
- 🐾 For Training Sessions have a word to tell puppy they are starting training and a word to end training but do remember whenever you are interacting with your puppy you are training
- 🐾 Do 5 to 10 repetitions of sit leave and name each training session
- 🐾 Discover what the high value treat for your pup is and bring to next class

WEEK 2

- 🐾 Continue short leash tie moving to different areas – stay with puppy – build up duration with puppy remaining calm
- 🐾 Introduce feeding ideas to keep your puppy busy, take longer to eat and tiring puppy out preventing a bored puppy that digs barks chews or other undesired behaviour.
- 🐾 Please read through Body Language of dogs in your manual to get to know how your puppy is feeling and other puppies are feeling
- 🐾 Do 5 to 10 repetitions of down eye to eye attention and stay in one place
- 🐾 Start getting puppy to sit in different locations, going to bed with further distance and leave moving to open hand and other objects – remember puppy never gets what its being asked to leave

WEEK 3

- 🐾 Tie- up everywhere you take puppy so they can calm with all distractions
- 🐾 Condition your puppy to touching all over and moving on to a surface when asked to replicate getting on scales for weight check or vet visits (this also helps puppies get use to different surfaces – teach puppy to shake and hold paw for longer periods – ensure bathing brushing nail trimming are all paired with treats – never force your puppy to do anything that worries them – always let them have a happy experience. Refer manual
- 🐾 Check equipment to use for walking your puppies Refer Manual
- 🐾 Train your puppy to accept equipment and muzzle
- 🐾 Train your puppy to come firstly short distances in familiar environments – every time your puppy checks in pay them so you are the most valuable thing in their life – never punish puppy for not coming back – wait and when puppy does return pay, pay, pay
- 🐾 Commence training your puppy to wait at door ways gates getting in or out of car until they are invited
- 🐾 Continue all training, moving to different locations with different distractions with longer durations
- 🐾 Keep vaccinations and worming up to date to protect your puppy's health - refer manual and your vet
- 🐾 Be aware of the current laws regarding where your puppy can and cannot go
- 🐾 Continue training all behaviours covered
- 🐾 Please don't train your puppy if you are not well, sad or angry instead just spend time with them
- 🐾 Have fun! Enjoy your puppy and remember Diesel & Blue are always available to assist with any behaviour issues
